
Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, store, disclose, and protect personal data when you interact with our websites, products, and services.

2. Scope

This policy applies to personal data collected via websites, customer and supplier relationships, recruitment, marketing communications, and customer support.

3. Personal Data

We process identification data, contact details, account data, commercial data, recruitment data, and technical data such as IP addresses and cookies. We do not intentionally process special categories of personal data.

4. Legal Bases

Processing is based on contract performance, legal obligations, legitimate interests, or consent. Consent may be withdrawn at any time.

5. Purposes

Purposes include service delivery, contract management, support, recruitment, marketing (where consent applies), website analytics, and legal compliance.

6. Cookies

Necessary cookies are always active. Statistics and marketing cookies are used only with consent, which can be withdrawn at any time.

7. Disclosure

Personal data may be shared with service providers, advisors, group companies, and authorities where required by law, under appropriate safeguards.

8. International Transfers

Transfers outside the EU/EEA are protected using Standard Contractual Clauses or adequacy decisions.

9. Retention

Data is retained only as long as necessary: financial records up to 5 years, recruitment data up to 6 months unless extended by consent, marketing data until consent is withdrawn.

10. Your Rights

You have rights of access, rectification, erasure, restriction, portability, objection, and withdrawal of consent.

11. Children

We do not knowingly collect data from children under 16 years of age.

12. Security

Appropriate technical and organizational measures are in place to protect personal data.

13. Complaints

You may lodge a complaint with the Danish Data Protection Agency (Datatilsynet).

14. Changes
